Year 10 Geography Field Trips – June/July 2021

As part of students' AQA GCSE Geography course, we are required to provide students with the opportunity to attend two field-work days.

The first day will be based on physical geography and will be a study of the changing characteristics along the River Tillingbourne near Dorking.

The second day will be based on human geography and will be a study of quality of life in Guildford. These fieldwork days are an essential part of the preparation for the students' Paper 3 'Geographical Applications' Exam in Year 11.
