When is the application deadline?

The online application form can be found [here](#) and should be completed no later than **Monday 14 December**

How many subjects should I pick?

The vast majority of students really should be looking for three courses. The application form allows for you to choose three and then a reserve.

Some students, especially mathematicians, will be very capable of completing four subjects. There is still the option for a reserve choice on the application form.

If a student is really unsure about which subjects to choose, after discussion with Sixth Form and their subject teachers, they should choose four subjects on the application form. In subsequent interviews students can let us know that they are looking to drop to three subjects.

Where can I get advice for subjects to choose?

The first port of call should be subject teachers. Then use the Prospectus to guide you in terms of complimentary subjects. After that you can ask at Parents' Evening. There will also be the opportunity during your interview to discuss combinations and your options can be altered. This may be welcome after completing more of a particular GCSE course. Any student can email or speak to Mr Phillips about their thoughts on subject choices and combinations throughout the year.
